

HOW TO ACCESS THE DIAMANT BUILDING

FROM THE AIRPORT

By taxi: some 20 minutes

By public transport (Train+Metro+Tram): Take the train from Zaventem Airport to Brussels Central station. 4 departures an hour from Zaventem: every hour +4 minutes, +26 minutes, +36 minutes and +52 minutes. Arrival Central station: 25 minutes later. From Brussels Central station, see below.

By public transport (Bus): Take the "Airport Line" (line 12) from Zaventem Airport and get off at Diamant, some 20 minutes later. On weekdays from 7.00 am to 8.00 pm you have a bus every 20 minutes (every 10 minutes on peak hours). You are on the Boulevard Reyers, you cross the Rue Colonel Bourg. Go along the Boulevard Reyers and you see the Diamant Building.

FROM BRUSSELS CENTRAL STATION

By public transport: Take the Metro, direction Stockel (line 1), change at Montgomery, take the tram 23 (direction Heysel) or 24 (direction Schaerbeek) or 25 (direction Rogier), exit at Diamant, take the exit "RTBF/VRT ". Coming out of the Diamant station, you are on the Boulevard Reyers, you cross the Rue Colonel Bourg. Go along the Boulevard Reyers and you see the Diamant Building

FROM THE GARE DU MIDI/ZUIDSTATION

By public transport: Take the Metro, direction Simonis (Elisabeth) (line 2 or 6). Change at Arts-Loi, take the Metro, direction Stockel (line 1). Change at Montgomery, take the tram 23 (direction Heysel) or 24 (direction Schaerbeek) or 25 (direction Rogier). Exit at Diamant, take the exit "RTBF/VRT ". Coming out of the station, you are on the Boulevard Reyers and you cross the Rue Colonel Bourg. Go along the Boulevard Reyers and you see the Diamant Building.

BY CAR

Coming from the motorway E40/A3 (Köln, Liège, Leuven, Kraainem, Brussels) or E40/A10 (London, Ostende, Gent, Brussels), E19/A1 (Breda, Antwerpen, Mechelen, Brussels) or E19/A7 (Mons, Charleroi), E411 (Namur) take the RING R0 round Brussels to the E40/A3 (Leuven, Liège, Köln) with direction Brussels centre.

Take exit 18 and access the Bld. Auguste Reyers; the Diamant building is on the right side, close to Belgium's national television and radio companies VRT and RTBF (tower).

You can park your car in the Parking of the Diamant Building at Bld. Auguste Reyers; level - 3 is foreseen for visitors.
